The staff is not including the CCQ in the inmate's medical file. The CCQ needs to be included with the inmate health screening form to be readily available to review by Commission staff.

During the walk-through, multiple maintenance issues were observed to include a leaky roof that has resulted in the east wing of the facility to be closed down. There is also no hot water on the east wing. Intercoms need to be added and intercoms need to be repaired. There were multiple lights that were not operating. Illuminated exit signs need to be installed.
